

LEADERS IN ACTION

Indiana Farm Bureau's Leaders in Action program will encourage community engagement as well as develop skills of leaders in order to enhance Indiana agriculture and rural and urban communities.

Apply online at www.infb.org/lia by Dec. 18. Only complete applications will be considered. Participants will be chosen based on application review. Space is limited. All applicants will be notified of their status by Jan. 6, 2018.

Cost: \$200 per person for Farm Bureau members, \$250 per person for non-members. Hotel rooms are provided only when meeting in Michigan City, Indianapolis and Washington, D.C. Some meals in D.C. will not be covered. Some county Farm Bureaus may choose to pay for participants. Payment is due no later than Feb. 24, 2018.

Attendance is required at all sessions to be eligible for the Washington, D.C. trip. All applicants must be at least 21 years old.
